This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated March 11, 1992, in response to our letter dated February 11, 1992, transmitting a Notice of Violation associated with Dresden Inspection Report Nos. 50-237/91039; 50-249/91043. We have reviewed your corrective actions and have no further questions at this time. These corrective actions will be examined during future inspections.

I have noticed, however, in my review of recent CECo responses, that you often do not provide precise dates when corrective actions will be completed. For example, in this reponse you advised that a procedure revision is "expected" to be issued by April 10, 1992. While the Region III inspection staff will track this matter to assure timely completion of corrective actions, I am requesting that you review CECo responses to assure that commitments are delineated appropriately and tracked accordingly.
