Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, Commonwealth Edison (CECo) proposes to amend Appendix A, Technical Specifications, of Facility Operating Licenses DPR-19, DPR-25, DPR-29 and DPR-30. The purpose of this amendment request is to update the leakage test requirements of the Drywell Airlock to the standards of 10 CFR 50, Appendix J, Section III.D.2 in response to an Unresolved Item listed in Reference (a) for Dresden Station. This amendment request satisfies CECo's proposed response to that Unresolved Item as discussed in Reference (b). It is requested that the amendment request be made effective sixty (60) days following approval to allow the station's sufficient time to update appropriate station procedures.

This proposed amendment is subdivided as follows:

1. Attachment 1 gives a description and safety analysis of the proposed changes in this amendment.
2. Attachment 2 provides a summary of the proposed changes for Dresden and Quad Cities Stations.
3. Attachment 3 includes the marked-up Technical Specification pages with the requested changes indicated for Dresden and Quad Cities Station.
4. Attachment 4 describes CECo's evaluation performed in accordance with 10 CFR 50.92(c), which confirms that no significant hazards consideration is involved.
5. Attachment 5 provides the Environmental Assessment.

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
The proposed amendment has been reviewed and approved by CECO On-Site and Off-Site Review committees in accordance with company procedures.
