Concerning the proposal by NuScale Power to build 12 SMRs at the Idaho Nuclear Laboratory

I strongly urge the NRC to protect public health and safety over any other pressures from or interests of commercial or governmental entities.

Do not shrink the Emergency Planning Zone for this new technology. Since the proposed new reactors have not been tested in the U.S. yet, we need to make certain that the nuclear industry's safety claims are accurate, before they are built.

Where will the increased accumulation of nuclear waste from this commercial reactor project be ultimately stored? at the INL, which sits over the Snake River Aquifer?

Please remember when making decisions that will affect our future generations' health and welfare that:
