**DECLARATION OF GREG URBAN**


I, Greg Urban, declare as follows:

1. My name is Greg Urban. I live at 1083 East Mountain Road, Guilford, Vermont. My home is less than five miles from Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station.
2. My family and I enjoy outdoor activities including gardening, hiking, canoeing, camping, and otherwise tending our grounds. We enjoy a clean and healthy natural environment, enjoy the peace of our surroundings and our community. We rely on local drinking water supplies and, to a substantial degree, on local suppliers for fresh fruits, vegetables, dairy products, beef, and other agricultural products.
3. I have canoed and kayaked on the CT River and its tributaries for many years. I have surveyed riparian, aquatic and island vegetation in the CT River for recreation. The potential of harm from a botched decommissioning to the CT River's flora and fauna would harm my enjoyment of the river.
4. I am a member of the New England Coalition and I have authorized New England Coalition to represent me in this license transfer proceeding.
5. I am concerned that a rushed decommissioning driven by cost-savings and performed by new owner with inadequate assets promises to the potential for the accidental spread of contamination and the harmful consequences of such release. I am further concerned that such releases to the environment will devalue my property and present a contamination risk to our water supply, local food supplies, as well as the CT River.
6. Also, I am concerned that the Vermont Yankee decommissioning, as it is proposed by NorthStar, may run short of funds and be forced back into Safstor or worse abandoned as a derelict industrial site. I am concerned that negative environmental impacts would be aggravated as more of the site would be opened and exposed to the weather.
7. If the NRC provides New England Coalition with a hearing in this case, they will be able to try to get the proposed license transfer rejected or modified to address the above concerns. This would

serve to protect me, my family, and my property from the risks involved in the license transfer of Vermont Yankee.
