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Patient Release Program; Extension of Comment Period

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## General Comment

I received 110 MCIs of RAI in Jan 2017 at the Beebe Hospital in Lewes, DE. One of the most disconcerting parts was the great disparity of precautions among medical practitioners / facilities about the process. After swallowing my pill, my husband and I walked through the main lobby of the hospital to our car. I was told I only needed three days of isolation and that my dog could be in the same room as me as the RAI exposure would not affect her. This was conflicting from information I learned from other reliable agencies.

I would like to see information that is adopted to be universally disseminated as a standard, not a suggestion, to be up to the interpretation of individual practitioners and institutions. When this happens, it leaves many worrying needlessly about the quality of care exposure damage to others.

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
