Dr. Murley,

The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC that the actions committed to by Commonwealth Edison (CECo) in response to Generic Letter 90-03 has been completed for the Dresden and Zion Nuclear Power Stations.

In reference letter 1, CECo projected that all requested actions would be complete by December 31, 1992. Those actions included the establishment of; control of the distribution and location of safety related vendor manuals and instructions; vendor interface for General Electric and Westinghouse manufactured safety related equipment; vendor interface for safety related equipment provided by the NSSS supplier; and a vendor interface for non-NSSS safety related equipment manufacturers.

Reference letter 2 provided an update for the six stations. At that time, all six stations had established control of the distribution and location of vendor manuals by administrative procedure. The Braidwood, Byron, LaSalle, and Quad Cities stations had completed the establishment of vendor interfaces for the safety related equipment identified in the Vendor Equipment Technical Information Program (VETIP). The Dresden and Zion stations were close to completion with the establishment of the vendor interface in the VETIP. CECo anticipated meeting the requirements of this Generic Letter and closing this issue by December 31, 1992. Dresden Station completed their final task on December 7, 1992 and Zion Station completed their final task on December 24, 1992. The actions required for this generic letter are now complete for all six stations and no further action is required.



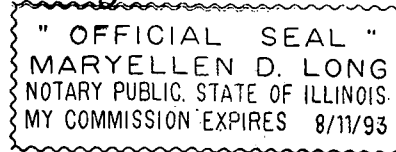
