Subject: Reinstatement of Individual SRO License Due to Job Position Change NRC Docket No. 55-30040

ComEd requests the reinstatement of Thomas J. Mohr's Senior Reactor Operator's (SRO) license for Dresden Units 2 and 3 to be effective upon his successful completion of the Licensed Operator Requalification examination in early 1995.

- 1) Background Information
 - a. Mr. Mohr's original SRO license date was July 9, 1982. He participated continuously in the station-administered Licensed Requalification program each year since his original license date until January, 1994.
 - b. Mr. Mohr successfully passed the station-administered requalification examinations each year between those dates. He also successfully completed the written examination portions of the requalification examination process in February, 1994.
 - c. Mr. Mohr was selected for, and successfully completed the NRC-administered requalification examinations in 1990.
 - d. Mr. Mohr relinquished his SRO license in January, 1994, when he assumed responsibilities not requiring an SRO license.
- 2) Reinstatement of the SRO license
 - a. Mr. Mohr has recently been reassigned to a job position in the Operations Department. Current plans are to return him to a position requiring an SRO license in the near future.
 - b. A review of his training since January, 1994, will be performed and accelerated requalification training will be conducted as needed.

Normal station procedures for accelerated training and on-shift watchstanding will be c. performed prior to returning his license to active status.

ComEd believes that Thomas J. Mohr's SRO license should be reinstated upon successful completion of the accelerated training and the 1995 station-administered requalification examination given in February of 1995, due to 1) his experience as a control room SRO and a Unit Operating Engineer, 2) his excellent performance over 14 years as a license holder, 3) his continuous involvement in the day to day operation of the plant and 4) the short period of time since relinquishing his license.

ComEd requests the NRC reinstate his license upon notification of his successful completion of the regualification examination, or specify a course of action which will result in timely reactivation of his license.
