We will no longer be performing PET/CT or ordering FDG under our license. Please amend our license to reflect this change by removing 100 Rawlins Drive, Seaford, DE 19973 as a location of use.

Radioactive sources stored on the PET/CT trailer were properly surveyed and sent via Cardinal Health to Nanticoke Memorial Hospital on June 9, 2017. A proper survey and wipe was performed on the PET/CT trailer prior to the trailer being relocated to a different facility as of June 13<sup>th</sup>.
