List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks: Holtec International HI-STORM Flood/Wind Multipurpose Canister (MPC) Storage System; Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1032, Amendment No. 3, Direct Final Rule; Part 72 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (Regulation Identifier Number 3150-AK03; NRC-2017-0089)

On June 28, 2017, the NRC published a direct final rule in the *Federal Register* ([82 FR 29225](#)) amending its spent fuel storage regulations by revising the Holtec International HI-STORM Flood/Wind MPC Storage System listing within the “List of approved spent fuel storage casks,” to include Amendment No. 3 to Certificate of Compliance No. 1032. Amendment No. 3 revises authorized contents to allow burnup credit for fuel types in the MPC-37 and revises CoC Condition 8, which has been previously incorporated in Amendment No. 2 to CoC No. 1032. The companion proposed rule was also published in the *Federal Register* on June 28, 2017 ([82 FR 29249](#)). Unless significant adverse comments are received, the direct final rule will become effective on September 11, 2017.
