#### **CORPORATE NUCLEAR OPERATIONS**

#### **Management Actions and Sanctions**

There were no positive test results requiring action during this reporting period.

Five hundred thirty (530) on-site tested negative quality control specimens were submitted to the SAMHSA laboratory during the first period 1996. All specimens were confirmed negative by the laboratory.

Blind performance testing was conducted at a rate of ten percent. Thirty-seven (37) specimens were submitted to the laboratory. All results were reported correctly.

Seven (7) FFD program violation appeals were received for the first period 1996. All violation decisions were upheld by the ComEd Executive Review Board.

One hundred ten (110) positive test results were verified confirmed positive by the Medical Review Officer. Additionally, during the period, two positive specimens were reanalyzed and re-confirmed positive.
