Subject: Dresden Nuclear Power Stations Units 2 and 3 Notification of Implementation of Technical Specification Amendments 150 and 145 for Combined Surveillance Intervals for Any Three Consecutive Intervals and Removing Instrument Locations from Post Accident Monitoring Instrumentation Locations NRC Docket Nos. 50-237 and 50-249

In reference (a) the NRC Staff provided final approval of the Technical Specification Upgrade Program (TSUP) for Dresden Station.

Within those amendments, the NRC Staff approved the change in the requirements which limited combined surveillance test intervals to less than 3.25 times the specified interval for any 3 consecutive performances. As described in reference (b), this change is consistent with those described in the NRC Generic Letter (GL) 89-14.

ComEd is implementing section 4.0.B to eliminate the requirement to continue to track surveillances to assure their performance within the 3.25 surveillance interval. This implementation will result in deletion of existing specification 1.0, item CC., Surveillance Interval, as well as addition of section 4.0.B.

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ComEd is also implementing the removal of the instrument readout locations from Table 3.2.6, Post Accident Monitoring Instrument Requirements. This implementation is being performed to permit the deletion of an internal Technical Specification guidance document. The change was specifically reviewed and approved by the NRC Staff as documented in section 3.6.1 of reference (c).
