The purpose of this letter is to report completion of the actions requested by reference (1) for Dresden Unit 3. Reference (2) provided the ComEd response to reference (1), and reference (3) amended the estimated completion dates for GL 96-01 based on revised dates for the unit refueling outages.

Surveillance procedures were revised and the associated systems were tested during the Dresden 3 refueling outage which is scheduled for completion in June 1997. Documents are available for review at the site.

Surveillance procedures common with Unit 2 were revised. The remaining procedure reviews and testing will be completed at the next Dresden 2 refueling outage currently scheduled for the spring of 1998.

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
