To leave the hospital I had to take the elevator to get out. When the elevator doors opened, there stood a pregnant woman and a toddler. I was terrified I'd expose them so I took the stairs. At the time I lived alone so my isolation was within my house. However if I had not lived alone, I don't know where I would go being afraid of exposing my family. I think being admitted to a monitored facility would be better for the mental and physical care BUT it would also have to be covered by insurance as most people could not handle the additional expense.

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
