We had a great deal of difficulty finding a place for our children and my wife to be while I was emitting large levels of radiation. It should not be a public health risk or familial risk to receive treatment. Our local hospital did not want to keep individuals going through RAI in the hospital due to cost, but the overall risk of exposure, especially for those undergoing multiple rounds, is very high for the general public, as well as household/family members.
