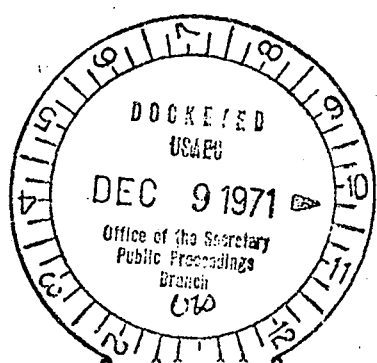

**COMMONWEALTH EDISON COMPANY, DRESDEN II REACTOR**

Mr. Arthur Gehr of Isham, Lincoln and Beale, counsel for Commonwealth Edison, called me yesterday afternoon to say that General Electric has asked Commonwealth to receive the fuel for Dresden II in advance of the delivery schedule originally planned. According to Gehr, General Electric's fuel fabrication facilities are becoming congested with completed fuel elements, and the company is asking its customers to agree to accelerated delivery schedules.

Mr. Gehr said that because the fuel storage facility at Dresden II is not ready, Commonwealth would propose to store the Dresden II fuel at Dresden I until it can be moved to Dresden II. Gehr proposed that the present indemnity agreement on Dresden I be amended to include the SNM license, at such time as it is issued, for preoperational storage of Dresden II fuel at Dresden I. He asked whether we would have any objection to such an amendment.

I discussed the matter with James Murray. He has no legal objection. Don Nussbaumer informed me that, subject to review of Commonwealth's storage plan and procedures, he saw no objection to the proposed storage at Dresden I.

I called Mr. Gehr this afternoon to tell him that we could amend the indemnity agreement, as he proposed, at such time as the necessary licensing action is taken to authorize storage of Dresden II fuel at Dresden I. I added that at such time as the fuel is moved to the storage facility at Dresden II, a further amendment to the indemnity agreement would be necessary to revise the "location" description to incorporate the Dresden II storage site.
