NOTICE OF DESIGNATION OF REPLACEMENT OF MEMBER  
OF ATOMIC SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD

By "Notice of Hearing on Application for Provisional Construction Permit," dated October 25, 1965, in the above captioned matter, the Atomic Energy Commission designated an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board consisting of Dr. Hugh Paxton, Los Alamos, New Mexico; Dr. Albert J. Kirschbaum, Livermore, California, and J. D. Bond, Esq., Chairman, Washington, D.
