Dear Shirley Xu,

I would like to make a formal request to amend U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Materials License No. 04-23910-01E. The amendment is to add timepiece model SWW-MP18 to Condition 10 with the intent to distribute.

The Smith & Wesson Military and Police Tritium timepiece, SWW-MP18 specifications:

- Case Material: Plastic
- Inner ring Material: Nil
- Dial and Hands Material: Brass
- Band Material: Rubber
- Buckle and Crown Material: Stainless Steel
- Japanese Movement
- The hands and marker at 12 has green tritium and the markers at 3, 6 and 9 features the orange tritium.

The chemical form and physical form is gaseous H-3(tritium) contained within borosilicate glass tubes. The amount of radioactivity in timepiece model SWW-MP18 is 10 mCi, never exceeding 19 mCi.

The source model numbers manufactured by mb-microtec are as follows:

	<u>Dimension (mm)</u>	<u>GBq.</u>	<u>Color</u>
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- T6043-1/I 0.65 x 6.60 0.135 Green

The method of binding of the byproduct material steps are as follows:

1. Gaps and adhesive film are applied to the sources. The factory fixes the white adhesive film on the backside of the hands and dial. The worker, using small plastic tongs (same as contact lens plastic tooling) picks up the source. The source is put on the gap and the gap underneath is white adhesive film. The source is then affixed in place.
2. A Minute track ring is added over the sources
3. Appliqué'/UV glue is applied to secure the ring to the source.

Enclosed as Attachment B is the technical drawing no. YC349 of watch model SWW-MP18.
