NRC Names New Senior Resident Inspector at Point Beach Nuclear Plant



The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has selected Tom Hartman as the new senior resident inspector at the Point Beach nuclear power plant. The two-unit nuclear power facility is operated by NextEra Energy Point Beach, LLC, and is located in Two Rivers, 13 miles northwest of Manitowoc, Wis.

“Tom Hartman’s combination of experience and education reflect his capabilities and dedication to the NRC’s mission of ensuring safe nuclear energy. As a senior resident inspector he will help ensure the plant maintains the high standards set by this agency,” said NRC Region III Administrator Cynthia D. Pederson.

Hartman joined the agency in Region III in 2009 as a reactor engineer. He previously worked as the senior resident inspector at the Callaway plant and before that the resident inspector at the Perry plant. Prior to joining the NRC he served nearly a decade in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Carl Vinson and as an instructor for a nuclear power training unit. He also worked as a licensed senior reactor operator. Hartman graduated from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute with a bachelor’s degree in nuclear engineering in 2000.

Each commercial nuclear power plant site in the United States has at least two resident inspectors who monitor day-to-day operations at the plant. Hartman joins NRC resident inspector Kevin Barclay at the Point Beach facility.
