Dear Mr. Keppler:

As requested by Reference (a) enclosed for your review is our response to the subject bulletin for Quad Cities Units 1 and 2. As stated in Volume 1 of the response there are still open items concerning the qualification data that is available for the equipment listed. Action is being taken to approach vendors and determine the status of these items by June 2, 1980. At that time a revision to this response will be sent to you.

The response contains an erroneous definition of one of the legend symbols used to indicate environmental conditions on the figures in Appendix C. The slashed area should also be defined as a temperature area. This along with the areas being more specifically defined for qualification purposes will be included in the June 2 revision.

The initial response to I.E. Bulletin 79-01B for Dresden Unit 3 will be available April 25, 1980. This delay is due to the fact that instrument indices for the plant, in some cases, did not agree with the field installations. Therefore extra time was taken to field check suspect items to insure the correct manufacturer and model numbers were used in the final report.
