

Subject: 'Dresden Station Units 1, 2, and 3 Quad Cities Station Units 1 and 2 Proposed Amendments to Technical Specifications to Incorporate Organizational Changes NRC Docket Nos. 50-10/237/249 and 50-254/265

Dear Sir:

Pursurant to 10 CFR 50.59, Commonwealth Edison Co. proposes to amend Appendix A, Technical Specifications, to Operating Licenses DPR-2, DPR-19, DPR-25 for Dresden Units 1, 2, and 3 and DPR-29 and DPR-30 for Quad Cities Units 1 and 2, respectively. These amendments incorporate recent corporate and station organizational changes.

The major change is the elimination of the two figures which illustrate the corporate and station organizations. These organization charts already exist and will remain in the Commonwealth Edison Topical Report No. CE-1-A, "Commonwealth Edison Company Quality Assurance Program for Nuclear Generating Stations." Revisions to this topical report also require review and approval by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Eliminating the duplication of information in the Technical Specifications and the Quality Assurance Manual (CE-1-A) will avoid errors, simplfy the review process, and eliminate future license amendments if organizational changes occur. Since these changes are administrative in nature only, they present no unreviewed safety question.

The proposed amendments are enclosed in Attachments 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 for Dresden 1, 2 and 3 and Quad Cities 1 and 2, respectively. These proposed amendments have received On-Site and Off-Site review and approval.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 170, Commonwealth Edison Co. has reviewed the proposed changes and determined them to be two Class II and three Class I Amendments. As such, a fee remittance in the 3 9960 WICHECK 4 3,600.00 amount of \$3,600.00 has been provided.
