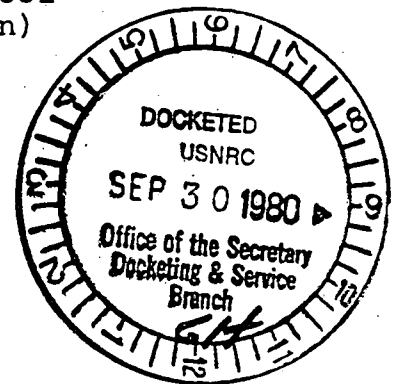



Terry Pickens is Project Engineer for the Dresden racks in Commonwealth Edison's Station Nuclear Engineering Department. Walt Shewski is Edison's Manager of Quality Assurance. Ron Ragan is Assistant Superintendent at Dresden Station. Don Adam is in charge of radioactive waste treatment at Dresden Station. Dr. Draley, you will recall, is at Argonne National Laboratories. Jim Gilchrest is the engineer in charge of the Dresden racks at Quadrex (NSC) and he will sponsor the Licensing Report. In addition, Edison may call upon Quazi Hossain and Kim Wong of Quadrex (NSC) to defend the structural and criticality analyses reflected in the Licensing Report, if the need arises. We are willing to make any or all of these people available to you for deposition prior to hearing at times which are mutually convenient.

To confirm the understanding we reached today on the telephone, the deposition of Dr. Robert Anderson will take place on October 27, 1980. In addition, the State of Illinois will make its other witnesses available for deposition the week of November 10, 1980. Please let me know who those other witnesses will be as soon as you can.
