Dear Mr. Grier:

Our letter of April 17, 1980 transmitted information in response to the remaining requests contained in I.E. Bulletin 79-01B. Niagara Mohawk committed therein to provide by March 31, 1981: a) qualification evaluation worksheets for components exposed to harsh environments, in the event of a high energy line break outside the primary containment, b) plans to address outstanding items for qualification of Limitorque valve operators, automatic depressurization system solenoids, and General Electric EB-5 terminal boards, found inside the primary containment, and c) radiation service conditions outside the primary containment following a LOCA-to be included in evaluation worksheets.

Niagara Mohawk has recently been informed of an improvement in the schedule of the work being performed by General Electric. As a result Niagara Mohawk now plans to provide the aforementioned response by December 31, 1980.
