Dear Sir:

Enclosed for your review is Revision 4 to the report, "Licensing Report Dresden Nuclear Power Plant Units 2 and 3 Spent Fuel Rack Modification," which was submitted with the proposed amendments of Reference (a).

Major changes in this revision include the following:

1. Corrected fuel storage rack arrangement to show the present layout.
2. Revised length of Boral from 144" minimum to show correct length of 156".
3. Deleted a reference to aluminium filler.

None of the changes effect the structural design or analysis of the racks and the maximum value of  $K_{eff}$  for the racks and the storage pool remains below 0.95, as stated in the original report.

As the result of open items identified in the public hearings for these modifications which were held on November 19-21, 1980, additional changes to the licensing report will be required. These changes will be provided as Revision 5 to the report as soon as they are finalized.

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
