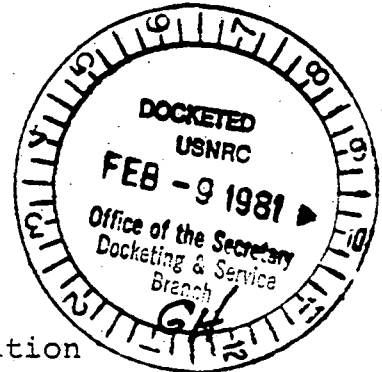

Enclosed are Deviation Disposition Requests (DDR's) which we have recently received from Nuclear Services Corporation/Quadrex, Documents D0001740 - D0001748. These DDR's are being produced pursuant to our informal discovery agreement since the record in this proceeding remains open. We do not believe, however, that these documents raise issues not addressed in the hearings of last November.

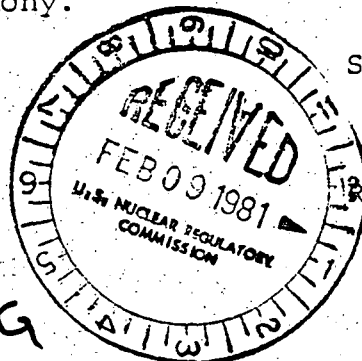
I have also enclosed documents relating to fuel channel bowing. It is my understanding that you have agreed with Phil to make a written request for any additional documents concerning this subject. I would appreciate this written request as soon as possible. Documents referred to in the written testimony filed on January 30, 1980 may involve proprietary information from Exxon, Cartech and GE and require some negotiation with these companies.

Finally, included among the fuel channel bowing documents is the draft testimony of Dr. O'Boyle which was used by Applicant as a technical working document and not solely as draft testimony. We are producing this document without waiving any NRC privilege we might have to other draft testimony.
