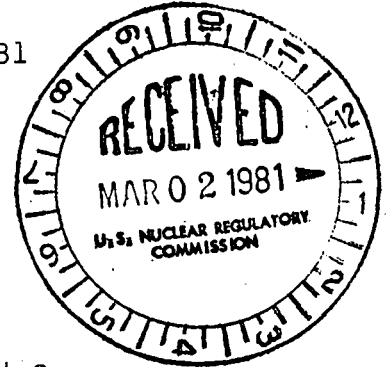



I.A.1.1 Shift Technical Advisor (STA)  
Dresden, Quad Cities and Zion Response

3. Trained per Lessons Learned Category "B"

Information needed to assess Commonwealth Edison Company's compliance with the STA training requirements was provided in the J.S. Abel letter to D. G. Eisenhut, dated February 24, 1981.

4. Describe Long-Term Program

This program, including plans for retraining and a comparison to INPO guidelines has been under intensive internal review recently, and is now scheduled to be submitted by March 16, 1981. This delay has been discussed with the Dresden, Quad Cities, and Zion NRC project managers.

II.K.3.2 Report on Overall Safety Effect of Power-Operated Relief Valve System

Dresden, Quad Cities Response

This item is not applicable to Dresden or Quad Cities Station.

Zion Response

This report is now scheduled to be submitted by the Westinghouse Owners Group in mid-March, 1981. The report will also address the need for an Automatic PORV isolation system as identified in NUREG 0737 item II.K.3.1.

II.K.3.5 Automatic Trip of Reactor Coolant Pump During Loss of Coolant Accident

Dresden, Quad Cities Response

This item is not applicable to Dresden or Quad Cities Station.

Zion Response

The LOFT experiment predictions by the INFLASH and NOTRUMP models are now expected to be submitted by early March, 1981 by the Westinghouse Owners Group. This delay was due, in part, to the delayed receipt of input data from the NRC.

III.A.2 Emergency Preparedness

Dresden, Quad Cities and Zion Response

Revised Generating Station implementing procedures have been submitted under a separate cover letter. (L. O. DelGeorge letter to H. R. Denton dated February 27, 1981).
