Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

References (b) and (c) identified the NRC Staff's intent to consider our previous amendment request of Reference (a) to be withdrawn.

Although this item has a low priority at this time, we do not consider the request withdrawn, only inactive.

Additional information requested by the NRC Staff in a January 5, 1977 letter has not been provided to date due to analytical problems. To address the Staff's request, additional analyses are required. At the time the request was made, LOCA analysis codes were under revision. In addition, conversion from one transient analysis code to another was in progress. Since the new codes have now been approved by the NRC Staff, we have renewed efforts to perform the analyses needed to answer the staff's questions in the January, 1977 letter.

Based on the above, we request that the NRC staff keep our original request in an inactive status, but not withdraw it. We

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
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plan at this time to continue efforts to perform the analyses required to support the amendments. If our plans change in this regard, we will notify you at that time to withdraw or otherwise dispose of our request.
