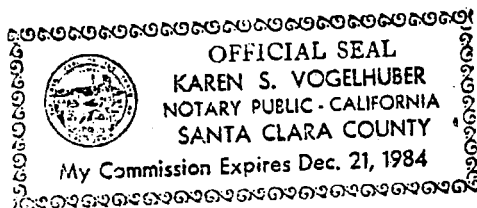

Public disclosure of this information would provide General Electric's competitors with significant competitive information which could be used to the substantial detriment of General Electric and hamper efforts to compete in the marketplace. For example, the information which relates to fuel channel bowing was developed at substantial expense and is not available to competitors. Thus, competitors would obtain significant competitive advantage if this information was released.
