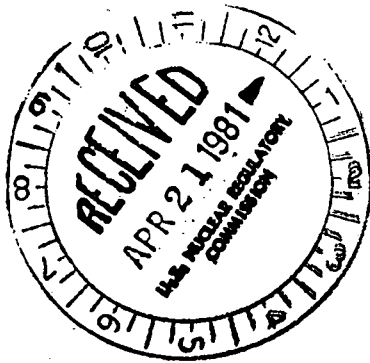

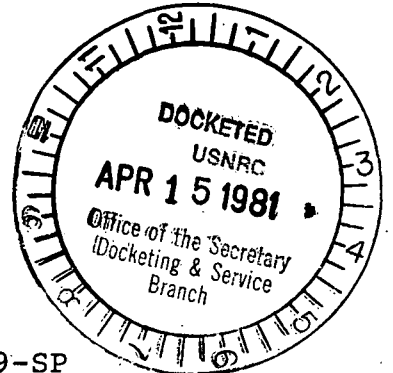



Dear Mary Jo:

On April 9, 1981 you requested documents relating to the NRC audit of NSC which took place in November, 1980. Enclosed as a professional courtesy are four documents relating to this audit which the NRC should have placed in the Public Document Rooms, but apparently has not. The NRC audit related solely to NSC's work on pipe stress analyses for Commonwealth Edison's La Salle County Nuclear Power Plant. They do not relate in any way to Dresden Station or to the proposed spent fuel racks which are the subject of this proceeding.

Also, on April 9 you renewed a request which you originally made on December 3, 1980 for an internal NSC audit report written sometime in 1980 by a man named Henry Thailer. As I informed you on December 11, 1980, this report relates solely to the La Salle Pipe Stress Project and has nothing to do with the Dresden spent fuel racks. (See attached 12/11/80 letter.) Moreover, this NSC internal audit report is not a public document. Accordingly, as I told you on December 11, 1980, we do not intend to produce this document. I suggest that if you wish to pursue the matter you make a motion to compel with the Licensing Board. We, of course, will have a copy of the internal audit report available for the Board's inspection on Monday.

Re: Dresden Spent Fuel

Dear Mary Jo:

On December 3, 1980 you asked Commonwealth Edison to produce an internal Quadrex/NSC audit report written sometime in 1980 by a man named Henry Thailer. After talking with your expert, Mr. Hubbard, we were able to locate the document you were referring to. It is a 10-page report dated April 4, 1980 from J. Weber, Audit Team Leader, to J. Goldin (both of Quadrex/NSC) entitled: "Internal Audit of LaSalle Pipe Stress Analysis and Support Design (SAR-0303)--Internal Audit Report Number 80-3." Mr. Thailer was a member of the audit team. As the name implies, this internal audit relates to Commonwealth Edison's LaSalle County Nuclear Power Plant, presently under construction. It contains no reference to the Dresden spent fuel rack job. Further, I am informed by Jim Gilcrest and Walt Shewski that the Quadrex/NSC project group working on the LaSalle piping project is entirely separate from the group working on the Dresden racks.

After careful review and discussion with Mr. Gilcrest and Mr. Shewski, we have concluded that this document is not relevant to the Dresden spent fuel rack proceeding, nor is it reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of relevant material. Accordingly, we will not provide this document to you pursuant to our agreement on informal discovery.
