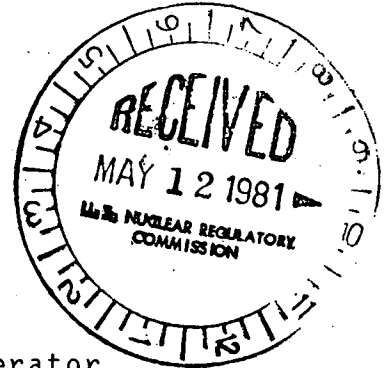

Commonwealth Edison has reviewed the staff evaluation on the above referenced topic transmitted by Reference A. The report is a correct statement of the facts except the rating of the diesel generator shown on page six of the report. The correct ratings are:

2860 KW at .8 P.F. for two hours  
2600 KW at .8 P.F. continuous

The report indicates the rating is 2860 KW at .8 P.F. for 2000 hours. This is a minor change in the context of the report and will not change the results of the evaluation.
