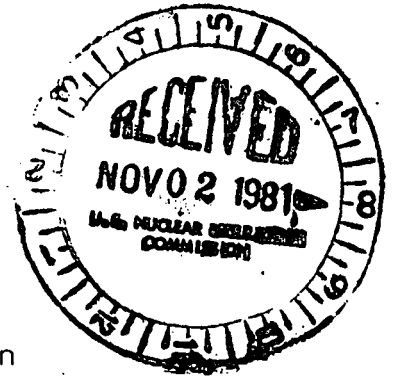

Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

In Reference (a), Commonwealth Edison agreed to provide draft Technical Specifications related to our proposed modifications to provide a second level of undervoltage protection for the emergency power buses at our operating nuclear facilities.

Draft Technical Specifications for Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad Cities Units 1 and 2 have been prepared, and are attached for your review. These draft changes have not received formal On-Site and Off-Site review and approval since an amendment is not being requested at this time.

The second level of undervoltage protection proposed by Commonwealth Edison meets the intent of IEEE-279 because the degraded voltage monitoring will be added to each redundant 4160 volt Engineered Safeguard Feature bus.
