Reference (a) requested all BWR licensees to provide plant specific responses concerning the guidance contained in NUREG-0803 within 120 days of receipt of the NUREG guidance. In an apparent contradiction, Reference (b), which forwarded NUREG-0803, requested that this response be made within 120 days of the August 31, 1981 letter date.

This is to inform you that Commonwealth Edison will provide a response for Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad Cities Units 1 and 2 by January 19, 1982, which is within 120 days of receipt of Reference (b).
