Dear Mr. Denton:

In response to NRC requests, Commonwealth Edison proposed in Reference (a) (supplemented by Reference (b)) to amend the Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad Cities Units 1 and 2 Technical Specifications concerning safety-related snubbers.

In the present refueling outage, during seismic piping systems reanalyses and modifications associated with I.E. Bulletin 79-14, six safety-related snubbers were removed from Dresden Unit 3. Accordingly, our Reference (a) submittal should be modified by removing the following snubbers from proposed pages 91e-1 and 91e-2 to the Operating License DPR-25 Technical Specifications:

This change has received On-site and Off-site review and approval.


