**Acknowledgement Statement**

I acknowledge that I have read the NRC Rules of Behavior for Authorized Computer Use, Version 1.4, and will comply with the terms and any applicable NRC policies, procedures, and rules governing the use and access to the NRC information technology resources. I understand that failure to comply with these rules may result in verbal or written warning, removal of system access and/or reassignment to other duties, criminal or civil prosecution, or disciplinary action, up to and including removal from Federal service.
