Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

Reference (a) requested that the Commonwealth Edison Company provide formal notification, within thirty (30) days, if we technically deviate from the NRC Staff stated positions of NUREG 0737 Item III.D.3.3 at our Quad Cities Station.

The requirements of this item regarding "Improved In-Plant Iodine Instrumentation Under Accident Conditions" have been re-reviewed, and it is our belief that Quad Cities Station does comply with Item III.D.3.3 stated positions without deviation. Although not requested, this letter is being provided as documentation of the results of our review.

Please note that Reference (b) indicated that the NRC Staff had previously inspected our implementation of this Item III.D.3.3 at both our Dresden and Quad Cities Stations and found it to be acceptable. This was discussed with Mr. Roby B. Bevan on July 26, 1982.


