Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

Reference (a) provided our response to Reference (b) for NUREG 0737 Item III.A.1.2 for Dresden Units 2/3, Quad Cities Units 1/2 and Zion Units 1/2. Part of this response included a commitment to provide our Reg. Guide 1.97 implementation schedule by December 31, 1982.

Since that time, additional guidance concerning the upgrade of Emergency Support Facilities has been set forth in SECY-82-111. We are also aware that a request for an integrated schedule for completion of the items in SECY-82-111, including Reg. Guide 1.97 implementation, will be issued from your office in the near future.

Based on the above, we no longer intend to provide our Reg. Guide 1.97 implementation schedule by December 31, 1982, but believe it is more prudent to provide it with the integrated response pertaining to SECY-82-111.
