Dear Mr. Denton:

In References (a) and (b), Commonwealth Edison informed you that we will provide a schedule for resolution of the proprietary information issue for Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad Cities Station Unit 1 and 2, respectively. All manufacturers whose proprietary reports were used in the Technical Evaluation Report have been preliminarily contacted. In most cases, only a portion of the manufacturer's reports were used. If the information used is found proprietary by the manufacturer, an affidavit will be requested by Commonwealth Edison, consistent with 10 CFR 2.790(b).

We are in the process of preparing a formal letter to each manufacturer which will request a timely response.

We will inform you of the status of this issue on May 15, 1983.
