Dear Mr. Denton:

During conversations with your staff on the proposed Technical Specification amendment contained in reference (a), we were requested to document by letter the testing requirements on the EMR logic change which is a part of this amendment. It is our intention to perform test at the time of installation and during each successive refueling outage consistent with the ADS logic checks the proper time delay setting and verification of the inhibit function in the control room.

Additionally, we will verify the inhibit function during the operability check on the relief valves performed after each refueling outage. Please address any questions on this matter to this office.
