Dear Mr. Denton:

Per our commitment in Reference (b) Commonwealth Edison is providing herein a DRAFT Technical Specifications for the RPS power supply monitor systems. This draft is in the format for Quad Cities Unit 2 (NRC Docket 50-265) and is attached to this letter. This wording, if found acceptable by the NRC, would also be applicable to the remaining three units. We have determined that operation with this RPS modification, installed in accordance with 10 CFR 50.59 and without applicable Technical Specifications does not in any way comprise the safe operation of these facilities. Justification for the setpoints were provided in Reference (b).
