Dear Mr. Denton:

Per a telephone conversation with R. Gilbert of your staff, Commonwealth Edison has been informed that the Franklin Research Center draft TER for Dresden Station contains the same three open items as did the Quad Cities TER. It is our understanding that if our positions on Quad Cities Station as stated in Reference (a) is also made applicable to Dresden Station Units 2 and 3 in all particulars the subject NUREG can be considered closed with no remaining open items. On the basis of this understanding and by this letter we commit to the resolution of the three open items for Dresden Station the same manner as for Quad Cities Station.

Please note, however, we will not submit a separate engineering analysis to verify if the stress design factors for Dresden Station's Dryer/Separator lifting rig is in compliance with ANSI N14.6-1978, Section 3.2. We will believe the Quad Cities Station analysis is also applicable and transmittal of a specific analysis for Dresden Station unwarranted.
