Dear Mr. Denton:

In response to the formal request made by reference (a), as supplemented by conversations between Commonwealth Edison Company and members of the Staff, the applicable justifications for continued operation (JCO's) currently being relied on both Dresden and Quad Cities Stations were submitted by reference (b). These JCO's demonstrate that failure of equipment items subject to 10 CFR 50.49 but lacking documented qualification will not prevent their respective systems from performing their intended safety functions. In the case of display instruments, there are sufficient alternate indicators available for appropriate operator decision making.

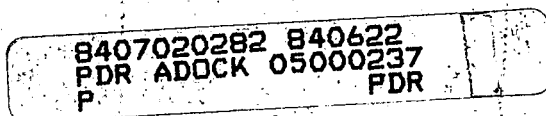
