Dear Mr. Denton:

In reference (a), Commonwealth Edison informed the NRC that due to NRC clarifications (such as Generic Letter 83-33) an independent review of the Dresden Stations fire protection program has been initiated, including a detailed reverification of compliance with Appendix R. This effort included a review of the previously docketed reports, a review of all previous commitments to ensure their completion, and a review to identify the applicable NFPA Codes and any significant deviation from them.

Commonwealth Edison met with members of your Staff on June 14 to present the results of the hot shutdown associated circuits portion of our review. At that meeting we committed to a formal submittal which will contain recently identified additional exemption requests, the schedules for both the previously identified modifications and the newly developed modifications resulting from the reviews mentioned above, and the appropriate interim compensatory measures. This submittal will be transmitted by August 3, 1984.

At that time, Commonwealth Edison Company will also provide a schedule updating the submittal dates for the remaining portions of our Appendix R review - spurious operation and cold shutdown.
