Gentlemen:

Under 10 CFR Part 71 a quality assurance program satisfying the provisions of paragraph 71.101 is required. Per the referenced letter, our Quality Assurance Program approval for Radioactive Packages has expired. Accordingly, and as provided under paragraph 71.101(f), we submit that Commonwealth Edison Company Quality Assurance Program for Nuclear Generating Stations, CE-1-A, Topical Report, Revision 31 which satisfies the applicable criteria of Appendix B of Part 50, fulfills the quality assurance requirements for transport packages covered by 10 CFR 71. The last revision which, per paragraph 50.54(a)(3), required NRC approval was accepted on June 29, 1984. This Company Quality Assurance Program is applicable to all our nuclear generating stations.
