Dear Mr. Denton:

Reference (b) contained a commitment to submit Technical Specification amendment requests for Dresden and Quad Cities Stations by August 15, 1984 assuming completion of the RETS review at Quad Cities and the TMI modifications at both sites. We have recently received approval of the Quad Cities RETS submittal, but some of the modifications will not be complete until the Fall of this year. It is still our position that a comprehensive submittal is preferable to piece meal submittals. In line with this thinking, we propose submitting a complete response with Technical Specification amendment requests by November 15, 1984.


