Dear Mr. Denton:

Per Reference (a), Commonwealth Edison proposed to amend Section 6 of Appendix A to the Technical Specifications for Operating Licenses DPR-19 and 25. During the review of that submittal the NRC had suggested several changes. Additionally, a revision to 10 CFR Sections 50.72 and 50.54 and a new Section 50.73 all effective January 1, 1984 had been issued which revised the minimum licensed operator staffing, immediate notification requirements and Licensee Event Report System respectively. Therefore, we updated our amendment request to reflect those changes in Reference (b) which included some changes to Section 3.12.

However, upon further review of both submittals addition changes were requested during a telecon with the NRC Project Manager for Dresden Station, the Region III Reviewer, and Commonwealth Edison. Those changes are being submitted formally by this updated letter.

The proposed changes are submitted in the new format used for DPR-19 and 25, approved by Reference (c). For ease of review, all of Section 6 is being submitted even if no changes occurred on a given page. All changes including those submitted by References (a) and (b) are enclosed and are noted by revision bars. A description of the most recent changes is provided in Attachment A.

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The proposed changes are enclosed in Attachments B and C. The attached changes have been received both Onsite and Offsite review and approval. We have reviewed this amendment request and find that no significant hazards consideration exists. Our review is documented in Attachment D. Commonwealth Edison is notifying the State of Illinois of our request of this amendment by transmittal of a copy of this letter and its attachments to the designated State Official.
