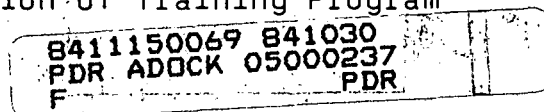

Dear Mr. Denton:

Reference (a) transmitted Supplement 1 to NUREG--737 requesting, among other items, emergency procedure implementation. Commonwealth Edison's position on Supplement 1 was detailed in Reference (b) and was negotiated with the NRC Staff. Our latest submittal on Emergency Operating Procedures was per Reference (d).

That submittal committed to an October 30, 1984 transmittal of the Procedures Generation Package to the NRC, an action confirmed per Reference (e). Enclosed in the form of an attachment to the letter is the Dresden Station Procedures Generation Package. The package consists of the following documents:

1. Plant-Specific Technical Guideline
2. Emergency Procedures Writers Guide
3. Verification and Validation of Emergency Procedures
4. Description of Training Program
