Dear Mr. Denton:

The referenced letter requested approval to use a mobile low-level radioactive waste volume reduction system (MVRS) at Dresden Station. To support that request, a Dresden specific Safety Evaluation Report (SER) on the operation of MVRS was submitted.

Based on subsequent discussions with members of your staff, Commonwealth Edison has revised its SER. This revision, dated December 31, 1984, is enclosed as an attachment to this letter.

We believe our revised SER, as reviewed against the SER which approved the Aerojet Topical Report, contains the information deemed necessary for any license applications and/or amendments which reference the MVRS.
