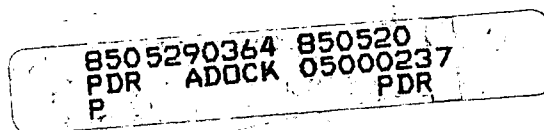
IDNS has reviewed the proposed Technical Specification amendment referenced above. We have determined no adverse findings as a result of that review.
