Dear Mr. Denton:

The referenced letter provided the NRC Staff's SER on TMI Item II.B.3 - Post Accident Sampling System. That SER found ten of the eleven criteria were met and that the only outstanding criterion, a core damage estimate procedure, was acceptable on an interim basis, until a final plant-specific procedure was submitted for both stations.

Enclosed as Attachments to this letter are the specific procedures. The respective procedures have been implemented at Dresden and Quad Cities Stations although Dresden's was not ready until late April. Implementation of these procedures and their transmittal to your Staff by this letter satisfies the outstanding items for II.B.3.
