Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, Commonwealth Edison requests approval for deletion of License Condition 3.F and a change to Section 4.6.2 of the Technical Specification both of which refer to the recirculation equalizer valves. These valves were required by Amendment 5 (Reference (a)) to be closed at all times during reactor operation and it is our intent to remove these valves and their associated piping during the upcoming Dresden Unit 3 outage. The outage is currently scheduled to begin September 1, 1985 - in order not to delay our work your approval of these proposed changes is requested by that date. These proposed changes can be found in Attachment A of this letter.

We have reviewed these proposed amendments and find that no significant hazards consideration exists as documented in Attachment B. Commonwealth Edison is notifying the State of Illinois of this request by a copy of this request to the designated State Official.

In accordance with 10 CFR 170, a fee remittance in the amount of \$150.00 is enclosed.
