Dear Mr. Denton:

The referenced Order required the Safety Parameter Display System (SPDS) be fully operational and operators trained by January 1, 1985, consistent with the definition of operable as stated in Reference (b).

As noted in Reference (c), several modifications were initiated in response to an Appendix I requirement which also serve as inputs to SPDS. The inputs could not be completed by January 1, 1985 and were targeted for completion this month. Additionally several other inputs were found not connected and new hardware is needed to complete that installation. Neither of these items are yet completed. Our current schedule suggests completion in August 1985. If the work is not completed by that time you will be duly notified.
